Qualifications for Candidacy

Requirements:

- Registered voter in Oregon.
- Must have resided within the city limits of Turner during the 12 months immediately preceding the election.
- All forms must be properly completed and returned to Lisa Nunnellee, City Elections Official, at Turner City Hall no later than 3:30 p.m. on August 22, 2024

¹ Oregon Constitution, Article II

Section 2. Qualifications of electors. (1) Every citizen of the United States is entitled to vote in all elections not otherwise provided for by this Constitution if such citizen:

(a) Is 18 years of age or older;

(b) Has resided in this state during the six months immediately preceding the election, except that provision may be made by law to permit a person who has resided in this state less than 30 days immediately preceding the election, but who is otherwise qualified under this subsection, to vote in the election for candidates for nomination or election for President or Vice President of the United States or elector of President and Vice President of the United States; and

(c) Is registered not less than 20 calendar days immediately preceding any election in the manner provided by law.

(2) Provision may be made by law to require that persons who vote upon questions of levying special taxes or issuing public bonds shall be taxpayers. [Constitution of 1859; Amendment proposed by initiative petition filed Dec. 20, 1910, and adopted by the people Nov. 5, 1912; Amendment proposed by S.J.R. 6, 1913, and adopted by the people Nov. 3, 1914; Amendment proposed by S.J.R. 6, 1923, and adopted by the people Nov. 4, 1924; Amendment proposed by H.J.R. 7, 1927, and adopted by the people June 28, 1927; Amendment proposed by H.J.R. 5, 1931, and adopted by the people Nov. 8, 1932; Amendment proposed by H.J.R. 26, 1959, and adopted by the people Nov. 8, 1960; Amendment proposed by H.J.R. 41, 1973, and adopted by the people Nov. 5, 1974; Amendment proposed by initiative petition filed July 20, 1986, and adopted by the people Nov. 4, 1986; Amendment proposed by H.J.R. 4, 2007, and adopted by the people Nov. 4, 2008]

Note: The leadline to section 2 was a part of the measure submitted to the people by initiative petition (Measure No. 13, 1986) and adopted by the people Nov. 4, 1986.

How to File

Step 1. Register* Your Campaign Committee:

Prospective candidates shall file a Candidate's Statement of Organization form (SEL 220) and Campaign Account Information form (SEL 223) with the Oregon Secretary of State's Elections Division.

This filing must take place within three (3) business days of receiving the first contribution or making an initial expenditure.

These filings are done electronically, and additional instructions can be accessed at <http://sos.oregon.gov/elections/Pages/orestar.aspx>. From this website, you can login and register with ORESTAR. For additional information, contact the Oregon State Elections Division at 1-503-986-1518.

Note: A candidate is not required to establish a campaign account, file a Statement of Organization, or file contribution and expenditure reports, if **ALL THREE of the following conditions are met:*

- 1. The candidate serves as the candidate's own treasurer;*
- 2. The candidate does not have an existing candidate committee; AND*
- 3. The candidate does not expect to receive or spend more than \$750 during a calendar year.*

Step 2. Filing for Candidacy:

Nomination petitions for city council shall clearly indicate one position for the candidacy that corresponds to a city council position that is to be filled in this general election.

Positions Open: Mayor (two-year term)
Councilor Position (four-year term)
Councilor Position (four-year term)
Councilor Position (four-year term)

Candidates Filing by Petition

Petition form must be approved by the City Elections Officer before you begin to gather signatures. The general information on the top should be completed before submitting to the Elections Officer. After your petition is approved, the City Elections Officer will return the form to you to start the gathering of signatures. Copies of this form should be made, and each sheet numbered before circulation.

After receiving approval from the City Elections Officer, circulate the approved petition (SEL 121) for signatures. Turner candidates must collect **15 valid signatures** to place a candidate on the ballot. *It is recommended that you collect more than the required number of signatures.* **Please note that a person cannot sign a nomination petition unless they are already registered to vote in Marion County.**

Remember, you must indicate on your forms whether you are filing for the Mayor or Councilor Position. Complete the two forms listed below and file them with the City Elections Officer.

Step 3. File Your Completed Petition:

Filing deadline: 3:30 p.m. on August 22, 2024

Please return all required forms, including the Certification of Qualified Elector/Residency form to Lisa Nunnellee, City Clerk, at Turner City Hall, 5255 Chicago ST SE, Turner, OR. 97392.

Step 4. Follow Campaign Finance Reporting Requirements:

Please review the *Campaign Finance Manual* for instructions and a schedule of filing deadlines. Campaign Finance forms are filed with the Secretary of State's Elections Division. All candidates are required to have a dedicated campaign bank account if they receive contributions or make expenditures over \$750 for the entire calendar year.

If you do not expect to receive a total of more than \$3,500 or spend a total of more than \$3,500 for an entire election, you may file a *Certificate of Limited Contributions and Expenditures* (PC 7). If at any time during the election, the total expenditures or contributions exceed \$3,500, you must file detailed contribution and expenditure reports.
