Allowing dirt, mud, and loose soil to be tracked, washed, or dumped on the street results in potential contamination of local waterways. Accumulations of eroded material in local waterways can result in impacts on water quality and fish habitats.

Required Conditions Detailed in Issued Permit	
1.	Inspect and maintain the erosion control measures to ensure intended function.
2.	Loose soil is to be confined to the project site and is not allowed in the street or adjacent property.
3.	The project must be stabilized at the end of each workday, ensuring no sediment is transferred off site.
4.	Construction material is prohibited from being buried on site.
5.	All temporary erosion control measures must be removed once final stabilization is achieved.
6.	Every project is subject to the conditions and penalties described in TRC 8.03 (City of Turner Erosion Control Ordinance).
A final stabilization inspection will be required during the final building inspection for the City of Turner.
