We will have 3 vacancies on City Council for the upcoming election, as well as the Mayor's seat.

Please see the Marion County Elections website (<https://www.co.marion.or.us/CO/elections/Pages/default.aspx>) and Secretary of State website (<https://sos.oregon.gov/voting-elections/Pages/default.aspx>) for information on filing as a candidate if you are interested.

We will also have this information available on the City of Turner website.

You must be a resident **IN CITY LIMITS** (& have been for at least the last 12 consecutive months). First date to file is June 6, 2026, with a deadline of August 25, 2026. *An incumbent seeking re-election to the same office must file their declaration of candidacy or nominating petition at least seven days before applicable filing deadline for non-incumbent candidates. Incumbent candidates that were appointed to the position they are seeking election to are subject to the same filing deadline as non-incumbent candidates.
