



Urban Renewal Project Grant Program

This urban renewal grant program provides limited grant funding to business owners and operators to promote business and economic development within the downtown Urban Renewal District of the City of Turner.

Project Types, Funding Limitations and General Process are Outlined Below

Grant Amount:	\$500-\$5000
Match Requirement:	50% documented cash match is required. No in-kind or volunteer donations can be included in the match.
Eligible Entities:	Any individual, organization or business may apply. Applications must be for a new project within the Urban Renewal District boundary: 4 th St to Turner Elementary, and from Gaston Rd to Turner Fire Station (see map on back).
Eligible Projects:	Projects must fall into the following general categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Building Support: Facade Improvement, Awnings, Infrastructure Upgrades, Safety Upgrades, etc. b) Customer Support: New Signage, Outdoor Benches or Landscaping, Sidewalk Improvements, etc.
Ineligible Projects:	Funding to support business operations, day-to-day repairs, or equipment.
Project Period:	The grant funded portion of the project must begin after the signing of a contract with the Urban Renewal District. Applicant will have one year from this date for completion of the project.
Reimbursement:	Funds will be distributed (within 14 days of accepted request) based on completed and submitted proof of expenditures and progress reports.
Application Process:	Prospective applicants are required to contact the Business Development Coordinator to discuss project eligibility prior to submitting an application. The application must include the following forms: Application Summary, Project Narrative, Project Budget, Assurances and Letter of Support (optional). Forms can be found at www.turneroregon.gov . Grant funding available on a first-come first-served basis until funds are exhausted.
Award Notification:	After approval by Urban Renewal Agency Board
